



## CLASSES OF ENTRY:

### DIVISION 1: HOME GROWN FRUIT Class

- 100: Apples – with stalks of one variety
- 101: Pears – with stalks of one variety
- 102: Plums – with stalks of one variety
- 103: A Dish of Soft Fruit/Berries – home grown
- 104: Any other Fruit – home grown



### DIVISION 2: HOME GROWN VEGETABLES Class

- 105: Potatoes – 5 of one variety
- 106: Carrots – 5 of one variety
- 107: Brassicas: Cabbage or Cauliflower – 1 head
- 108: Beans – 5 of 1 type
- 109: Leeks – 3
- 110: Salad Leaves – a collection of salad leaves – at least 3 types
- 111: Onions – 3
- 112: Cucumber – 1
- 113: Tomatoes – 5 fruit with calyx
- 114: Pumpkin or Gourds – 1 large or collection of 3 smaller ones
- 115: Marrows or Courgettes – 1 large or 3 small ones
- 116: Peppers – 3 of red, green or yellow
- 117: Chillies – 5 red or green
- 118: Aubergines – 2
- 119: Amaranth – 1 bunch
- 120: Kudu – 1
- 121: Garlic bulb with leaves
- 122: A collection of Vegetables – 5 distinct kinds
- 123: Oddest shaped Vegetable
- 124: Longest Runner Bean
- 125: Best Giant Vegetable (Any type)
- 126: Any other Vegetables – 1 large or 3 small ones



### DIVISION 3: HOME GROWN HERBS Class

- 127: 1 bunch of Mixed Herbs

### DIVISION 4: HOME GROWN FLOWERS & PLANTS Class

- 128: A Cactus or Succulent – one in a pot
- 129: Flowering Pot Plant – one of any kind
- 130: Foliage Pot Plant – one of any kind

### DIVISION 5: HOME GROWN CUT FLOWERS Class

- 131: Roses – 3 blooms of one or more varieties
- 132: Annuals – a mixed collection
- 133: Perennials – a mixed collection
- 134: Trees and Shrubs – one spray each of 2 different flowering varieties
- 135: Dahlias – 3 blooms of any variety
- 136: Chrysanthemums – 3 blooms of any variety
- 137: Seed Heads – a mixed collection
- 138: Best Garden Flower – 1-3 blooms



### DIVISION 6: FLOWER ARRANGING Class

- 139: Fresh Cut Flower Arrangement – any type
- 140: Dried Flower Arrangement – in an imaginative container

### DIVISION 7: HOME MADE PRESERVES/SAUCES Class (only one entry in each class)

- 141: Jar of Chutney – any kind, any size of jar
- 142: Jar of Pickles – any kind, any size of jar or bottle.
- 143: Jar of any kind of Fruit Jam or Jelly – 1lb approx.
- 144: Jar of locally produced Honey – 1lb approx.
- 145: Jar of Marmalade – 1lb Approx. – any type
- 146: Jar of Hot Sauce



### DIVISION 8: HOME MADE DRINKS Class

- 147: One bottle of Lemonade
- 148: One bottle of Ginger beer
- 149: One bottle of any other Fruit/Flower or Root Drink
- 150: One bottle of Wine or Cider

### DIVISION 9: HOME COOKING Class

- 151: A plate of 6 Cookies – any type
- 152: 6 iced and decorated Fairy Cakes
- 153: 6 Scones – any type
- 154: A Chocolate Cake
- 155: A Ginger Cake
- 156: A Carrot Cake
- 157: A Coffee and Walnut Cake
- 158: A Victoria Sponge Cake
- 159: A Fruit Cake
- 160: Traditional 'Tottenham Cake' (research this cake!)
- 161: An iced and decorated Special Celebration Cake – any type
- 162: A Gluten-free Cake
- 163: A Vegan Cake



- 164: 6 Onion Bhajis
- 165: 3 Vegetable Samosas
- 166: 3 Meat or Veggie Patties or Pasties
- 167: Bread Loaf – white flour – any shape or size

- 168: Bread Loaf – brown/wholemeal flour – any shape or size
- 169: A savoury Vegetarian Flan or Quiche – (min. 7cm diameter)
- 170: A Fruit Tart/Pie – (min. 7cm diameter)

### DIVISION 10: CHILDREN'S SECTION (12 and under) Class

- 171: A dish of Home-made Sweets – minimum of 6 – any type
- 172: 6 Fairy Cakes or Tarts – any type
- 173: 6 Biscuits or Cookies – any type (avoid chocolate as it melts if weather is hot)
- 174: A Large Cake – any type
- 175: A Bottle of Lemonade
- 176: A Miniature Garden in a recycled box, tin or flower pot
- 177: Cress Head grown in a decorated egg shell
- 178: A Face or Character made from Fruit and Vegetables
- 179: An Edible Necklace
- 180: A Flower and Foliage Arrangement in a jar
- 181: A Painted/Printed T-shirt
- 182: A decorated Hat or Crown made from paper or card
- 183: A Model made from recycled materials
- 184: A Pot made of papier mache or clay
- 185: A hand made Greeting Card
- 186: A hand made Christmas Tree Decoration
- 187: A Mosaic item
- 188: A DIY bird box/feeder or other wildlife friendly item



### DIVISION 11: HANDICRAFTS Class

- 189: A Hand-Knitted or Crocheted article
- 190: An article of Embroidery or Tapestry
- 191: A Patchwork or Appliquéd article
- 192: A Knitted Soft Toy or a Dressed Doll
- 193: A Hand Made article of Wood
- 194: A Hand Made article of Clay
- 195: A Hand Made Greeting Card
- 196: An Item of Hand Made Jewellery (Not too valuable!!)
- 197: A Collage – maximum size 50cm square
- 198: A Hand Made Christmas Tree or window Decoration



### DIVISION 12: SWEETS Class

- 199: 12 x Honey comb (cinder toffee)
- 200: 12 x Pieces of Fudge
- 201: 12 x Coconut Sweets
- 202: 12 x any other kinds of Sweet (avoid chocolates as they melt if the weather is hot)
